This portion of the class is covered in the registration fee.

IMPORTANT FLOWER SHOW SCHOOL INFORMATION

Any interested person may attend Flower Show School full or part time. Those wishing to become Flower Show Judges must attend all sessions and must complete the test on Saturday. For accreditation, a student needs to be a member of a local NGC Garden Club.

Note: For full credit, students must be seated by 8:15 am on 2/19/26 and 2/20/26.

*And be present for both **Zoom** instruction and Flower Show Procedure presentation. All students must attend the Saturday session to complete the necessary written tests.*
